Day Experiences

Scenic Helicopter Excursion

Enjoy an aerial view of the Okavango Delta while soaring above a vast maze of both permanent, fleeting waterways and floodplains. Fly over rivers and pools dotted with lily pads, as well as a variety of wild animals that inhabit this unique habitat, showcasing the sheer enormity of the Okavango Delta. For an even unforgettable experience, add a remote champagne stop and enjoy some French champagne in the bush.



Tsodilo Hills Rock Paintings

Enjoy a helicopter excursion to Tsodilo Hills, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where over 4500 rock paintings dating back to an estimated 26 000 years, adorn the quartzite rocks. The hills are sacred to the San Bushmen who utilised the caves until the late 20th century. Guests are accompanied by a San guide who will explain the fascinating artwork.



Explore your environment in modified open 4 x 4 vehicles on morning and afternoon game drives. Another great way of exploring the bush is on walking safaris. This offers a different perspective, one that is up close and personal with the surrounding environment. Other areas offer activities such as sundowner cruises, mokoro trips, and cultural excursions.

Victoria Falls Day trip

Victoria Falls constitute one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the world. The Falls and surrounding area have been declared National Parks and a World Heritage Site. Fishing

Fishing in the Delta is a seasonal activity, with excellent bream fishing from May to September and superb chances of landing tigerfish during September to mid-November. Enjoy motorboat trips to some of the Delta's best fishing spots, for a chance to experience the beautiful surroundings before landing a variety of species such as tilapia and tiger fish.

Horse Riding Safari

An exciting and different way to savour the Okavango Delta and experience its unique wildlife population - on horseback. The annual flooding leaves vast swathes of the Delta inaccessible to vehicles, making horseback riding a natural and thrilling way to truly explore this Eden of wildlife. The pace of riding varies with opportunities to gallop alongside giraffe, zebra and the numerous antelopes and slower walks as you stalk the bigger game like buffalo and elephant. Horseback safaris are also a fantastic opportunity to enjoy some of the world's best bird viewing.
