This remote and uncrowded island is part of the Zanzibar archipelago and is renowned for its unspoiled beaches and crystal-clear waters.

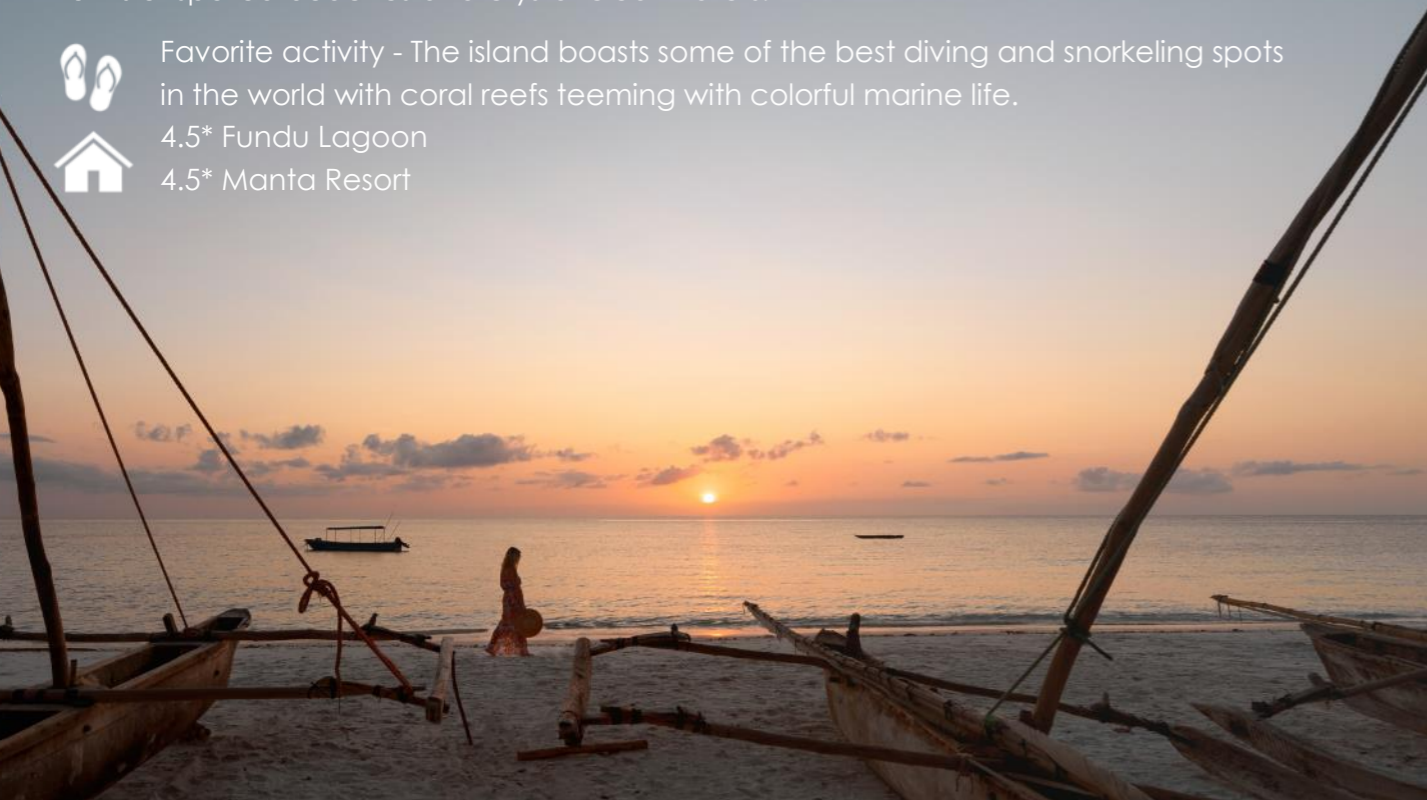


Favorite activity - The island boasts some of the best diving and snorkeling spots in the world with coral reefs teeming with colorful marine life.

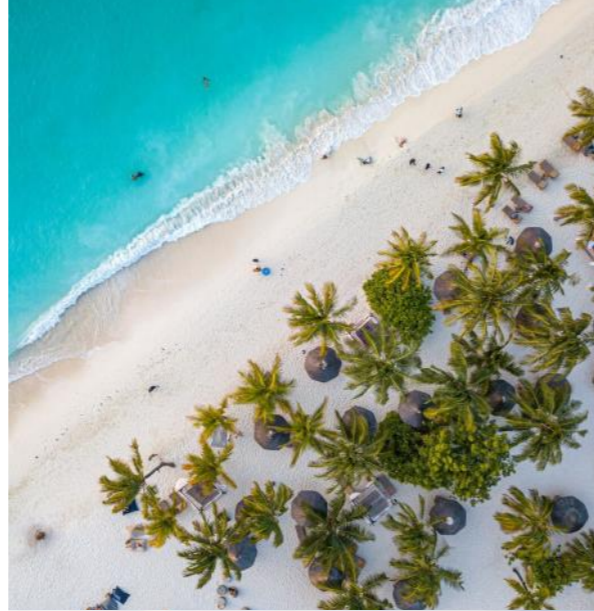


Favorite activity - Visiting the seaweed center and learning about its magical properties.
