FLAVORSOF SOUTH AMERICA

Argentine Alfajores


Many times we've said that Argentines surely know how to eat well, consistently and, most of all, deliciously, and that is specially true when it comes to pastries and desserts! With this in mind, today we're bringing you a great recipe from the south, which will allow you to easily become the favorite aunt or uncle, while giving you an ace up your sleeve to spoil your couple at midmorning.

What you will need?

- 1 ¾ cups unbleached all-purpose flour
- 2½ cups cornstarch
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 3/4 cup white sugar
- 3 egg yolks
- 1 teaspoon vanilla rum
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon lemon extract
- 2 teaspoons lemon zest
- 1 (11.5 ounce) jar dulce de leche
- 1/2 cup unsweetened shredded coconut

Directions

- 1. Whisk together the flour, cornstarch, baking soda, and baking powder; set aside.
- 2. Beat the butter and sugar with an electric mixer in a large bowl until light and fluffy. Add the egg yolks one at a time, allowing each yolk to blend into the butter mixture before adding the next. Beat in the vanilla rum, vanilla extract, lemon extract, and lemon zest with the last egg. Gently fold in the flour mixture with a spoon, making a crumbly dough. When the dough becomes cohesive enough, press it together into a ball with your hands. Wrap with plastic wrap and chill for 30 minutes to 1 hour.
- 3. Roll out the dough, using as little flour as possible, about 1/4 inch thick. The dough will have an unusual consistency. Cut with a small round cookie cutter, and place them 1/2 inch apart on the prepared cookie sheets.
- 4. Bake in the preheated oven (350F°-175C°) until set but not browned, 7 to 10 minutes.
- 5. Spread the underside of a cooled cookie with a teaspoon of dulce de leche, then sandwich together with another cookie until the caramel oozes out the sides. Roll the sides in the shredded coconut.
