DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day one: Arrive Victoria Falls International Airport, transfer to the camp and overnight. Day two: A trip to Victoria Falls National park should be at the top of your activity list for the day. Depending on the time of year, be prepared to get a little wet as you step into what almost feels like a temporary rain forest during the early months of the year, naturally created when the falls is at it fullest and the spray is heavier than usual. If you did not have time to explore the town of Victoria Falls yesterday, be sure to head out into the town exploring its little shops selling curios, coffee, clothing with local print designs as well as the many arts and crafts areas. For those who are adventurous at heart, there are plenty of activities such as zip lining, bungee jumping, ATV experiences and white water rafting to get your adrenaline flowing. For those who are looking to kick back and relax, we suggest a sunset cruise on the mighty Zambezi river. It is the perfect way to end any day, with a local Zimbabwe beer or your favourite cocktail in hand as you cruise along the river watching the African sunset. If you so happen to be an avid fisherman, be sure not to miss out on the fantastic tiger fishing that is available. Day three, four and five: Transfer to Victoria Falls International Airport for your shared light aircraft flight to Hwange National Park where you will be met by the camp quide and vehicle. Here you will have a wide range of land based activities, compared to water based experiences you have had for these past two days. At Hwange National Park this is where your Big Five experience starts to take off as you come across large herds of elephant, various predators and a variety of other fauna and bird species during your morning and afternoon game drives. Keep your camera ready, you never know what you will stumble upon as you come around the corner. **Day six:** Transfer to the airstrip for your shared light aircraft flight to Mana Pools. On arrival you will be met by the camp quide and vehicle and transferred to the property. Day seven & eight: The Mana Pools National Park is a pristine area, still very much untouched by humans. It is rural and rustic and has that "this is Africa" feel to it. Venture our exploring the region and enjoy the variety of wildlife teeming around the river system. Many of the animals stay close by to the region because of its water, and so do the predators. Have you ever watched an elephant take a shower? You just might get lucky as the elephants love to play in the shallows of the river.

Day nine: Transfer to the airstrip for your shared light aircraft flight to Victoria Falls International Airport for your onward flight and journey.
