

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day one: Arrive Windhoek International Airport, transfer to the hotel and overnight. **Day two**: Transfer to Eros Airport for your scheduled light aircraft flight. On arrival you will be met by the camp guide and transferred to the lodge.

Day three: The amazing expanse of 'nothingness' is what is so incredible about this region of Namibia. Its just miles and miles of sand and dunes. Sossusvlei's claim to fame is that it is home to the largest and tallest sand dune in the world. Enjoy walking up the dunes and sandboarding down.

Day four and five: Transfer to the airstrip for scheduled shared light aircraft flight to Swakopmund. Swakopmund is a lovely little coastal town, very rich in German history, culture and cuisine. It is a great town to enjoy activities like ATV experiences on the sand dunes, or talking guided walks out into the dessert in search for dessert adapted reptiles and small critters that live in this terrain. You can also head out on a catamaran cruise to Seal point in search of seals, while enjoying champagne and oysters as you cruise along. Visit many of the local bars and restaurants and enjoy authentic German beer and food freshly served up all day everyday.

Day six and seven: Transfer to Swakopmund Airport for your shared light aircraft flight to Twyfelfontein in Damaraland. Nestled between the massive boulders and rocks, this stunning little property will leave you enjoying its architecture and unique location. Grab your favourite cocktail and find a comfortable seat, the view of the sunset is about to blow your mind. Explore this UNESCO World Heritage site with self guided walks, or guided walks to explore the many rock art paintings that exist in the area. The region has the highest concentration of rock art in Africa.

Day eight: Transfer to the airstrip for your shared light aircraft flight to Ongava, transfer to the camp and overnight.

Day nine: Enjoy your morning and afternoon game drives, amongst many other activities, as you head out in search of desert adapted animals in terrain that is very different to the rest of Southern Africa.

Day ten: Transfer to the airstrip for your shared light aircraft flight to Windhoek Eros Airport, transfer to the hotel and overnight.

Day eleven: Transfer to Windhoek International Airport for your onward flight and journey.
