
QUINTESSENTIAL ZAMBIA - 8 NIGHTS

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day one: Arrive Livingstone International Airport where you are met by your Akorn representative and transferred to the lodge.

Day two: Start the day off with a trip to Victoria Falls National Park and, depending on the time of year, be prepared to get a little wet as you step into what almost feels like a temporary rain forest during the early months of the year, naturally created when the falls is at it fullest and the spray is heavier than usual. Enjoy a delicious lunch back at the lodge then set out on a sunset cruise on the mighty Zambezi river. It is the perfect way to end any day, with a local Zimbabwe beer or your favorite cocktail in hand as you cruise along the mighty river. If you so happen to be an avid fisherman, be sure not to miss out on the fantastic tiger fishing that is available.

Day three: Transfer to Livingstone International Airport for your shared light aircraft flight to the Lower Zambezi airstrip. You will be met by the camp guide and vehicle on arrival and do a game drive back to the property.

Day four & five: The Lower Zambiezi National Park has managed to retain its essence of true wilderness and provides a unique safari experience. With few visitors and a remarkable concentration of wildlife safaris here harken back to Africa's hey day. On morning and afternoon game drives, or when out on the Zambezi River, you will pass by huge numbers of elephant, buffalo, hippos, lions and even the elusive leopard. Take in the magic of this incredible area over the next two days and learn all you can from your superbly knowledgeable guides.

Day six: Transfer to the airstrip for your shared light aircraft flight to Mfuwe Airport, on arrival you will be met by the camp guide and vehicle and transferred to the property. **Day seven & eight**: Very few places in Africa offer the unique combination of South Luangwa National Park's open, grassy plains and mature, mesmerizing woodlands, crowned with the pristine, impressive Luangwa River. This area's reputation for abundant wildlife and unspoiled vegetation is well earned, so whether driving around or walking through, make sure you take the time to appreciate this un-spoilt corner of Zambia.

Day nine: Today you bid farewell to this beautiful country. after breakfast you will drive to the airstrip for your shared light aircraft flight from Mfuwe Airport to Lusaka International Airport for your onward flight and journey.
