DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day one: Arrive at Livingstone International Airport where you are met by an Akorn representative and transferred to your lodge.

Day two & three: Set within the tree line along the edge of the magnificent Zambezi River the lodge is perfectly situated for unspoilt views across the river into the Zambezi National Park, home to an array of wildlife and birds in an area of abundant natural beauty. Activities available including tours of Victoria Falls on the Zambian side, sundowner cruises, tiger fishing, and visiting a nearby village. The history of Zambia's Jewish community is a personal passion for Peter Jones, an owner of The River Club. His enthusiasm for the subject has led him on a journey from the past to the present. Both kitchens are laid out according to kosher rules. All cutlery, crockery, utensils, equipment etc. are stored permanently in these kitchens and used only for Kosher catering. All food and ingredients are strictly kosher.

Day four: Transfer to Livingstone International Airport for your scheduled flight to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport for your private transfer to the lodge. The lodge is situated in the world renown Sabi Sand Reserve within the Greater Kruger National Park.

Day five, six & seven: The days are at leisure to enjoy the lodge activities on offer. The Lodge offers an exciting African wildlife experience, from the memorable Big Five game viewing, to the fascinating insights into the tribal customs of the local Shangaan people. Explore the area on early morning game drives or set out on foot to see the smaller, but no less important creatures, of the eco system. Once again the kitchen is laid out according to kosher rules.

Day eight: Transfer to the airstrip for your private light aircraft flight to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport for your scheduled flight to Cape Town.

Day nine, ten & eleven: Spend the next three days exploring the beautiful city of Cape Town. Make your way up Table Mountain by cable car and enjoy the magnificent vista's over the Mother City. Embark on a scenic drive along Chapman's Peak or visit the penguins at Boulders Beach. Sail out to Robben Island and learn about the rich history and culture of the prison, now a World Heritage Site. For the more active guest, enjoy Scootours, side cars, a hike around Kirstenbosch Gardens or the Cape Peninsula. For the Art enthusiast pay a visit the Zeith Mocaa and spend time at the South African Jewish museum. A home hosted meal can be arranged to engage with the local Jewish community.

Day twelve: Transfer to Cape Town International Airport for your onward flight.

FRIDAY SHABBAT MEAL

Our Jewish Hop On Guide, Ivor, alongside his wife, enjoys hosting Jewish guests at their home for a Friday night Shabbat dinner. On arrival enjoy a welcome drink ranging from fruit juice to a whiskey and a bit of "getting to know you" conversation. Traditional blessings over wine (kiddush) and bread (challah) will be performed together with blessings for the guests. Dinner is served in the dining room, consisting of

a starter, followed by a main course of either fish, meat or vegetarian with accompanying vegetables and salads, ending with a fruit platter and apple or plum pie.

Thereafter if preferred, there would be grace after meals (full or shortened versions) followed by tea or coffee in the lounge. The home and all food served, whether bought or home prepared, would be Kosher.

JEWISH CULTURAL TOUR OF CAPE TOWN

Experience the history of the Jewish Community's roots in Cape Town's city centre as well as witnessing the growth of a healthy and vibrant community.

The South African Jewish Museum, opened by Nelson Mandela in 2000 is situated on the heritage site of the Gardens Synagogue built in 1863. It also houses the Cape Town Holocaust Centre and the Gitlin Library. The Cape Town Holocaust Centre, the first in Africa, explores racial and religious intolerance, ideological conflict and persecution, echoing the human rights abuses of the apartheid era in South Africa. We will also visit the Great Synagogue.

Depending on the timing of the day, we could also walk through the Company Gardens. The gardens offer a fresh produce garden for visiting ships from the mid-17th Century. It is also home to the Houses of Parliament as well as Cape Town's Jewish Campus and you can discover a little-known artefact in the South African National Gallery.
