DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day one: Arrive at Richards Bay Airport where you will be met by the camp guide and vehicle transferred to Phinda Private Game Reserve.

Day two, three & four: Being in one of the best game reserves in the region your safari is bound to be one of the most memorable experiences ever. Start off your days with early morning game drives at the crack of dawn, when the temperatures are still low and it's cool enough for predators to hunt. Experience the thrill of tracking wildlife as you and your guide look for fresh footprints from animal movement that took place the night before. Return back to camp for a sumptuous breakfast as you sit around the table planning the relaxed and easy day that lies ahead. Head out for guided bush walks, grab your favourite book and enjoy it on your private deck, relax by the pool, or even enjoy a mid-afternoon nap. You could also pamper yourself with a visit to the wellness centre or keep yourself fit with a great workout at the fitness centre. Why not get involved in participative conservation experiences such rhino notching, elephant collaring or pangolin tagging. With such a wide variety of things to do, you could do them all, or if you wish, do absolutely nothing at all, which ever works for you. **Day five**: Today you will be transferred to The Oyster Box.

Day six & seven: The Oyster Box hotel has a prime location in the area; this is the best spot in Kwa-Zulu Natal to kick back and relax at the seaside. Take off your shoes, and put on your flip flops, its time to get some sand in-between your toes. Enjoy swimming in the warm waters of the Indian Ocean and long walks on the beach. Frolic in the hotel swimming pool and enjoy freshly prepared cocktails being served poolside. Their curry lunch is world renowned and their high tea is just as popular.
