Best time to travel in East Africa

Kenya & Tanzania

Year-round destinations:

January - March: Hot dry months | low water levels | short grass | wildlife fight over resources | migration is calving in the Southern Serengeti

April - May: Rains arrive - intense thunderstorms & rainbows | lush, green and wildflowers abound | lowest visitor numbers

June: Rains cease | crisp clear skies | longer grass | migration moves up the Western Corridor

July - September: The migration arrives in the Northern Serengeti & Masai Mara | numerous river crossings

End-September - October: Grass dries out | limited water sources | migration moves back down into the Serengeti

November: Short rains arrive and provide relief for the wildlife

December: Rains stop | end of December resources are getting limited again

Uganda & Rwanda

Gorilla and chimpanzee tracking is possible all year round.

January - May: The rains gradually increase throughout these months | trees are heavy with fruit | primates are full and content

June: Rains cease | crisp clear skies

July - September: Driest months only a few scattered thunderstorms over the mountain ranges

October - December: Rainfall increases throughout these months and happen a few times a week by December

East Africa

Wildlife

The wildlife in East Africa, specifically in Kenya and Tanzania, is found in higher concentrations than elsewhere on the continent; the great wildebeest migration alone contains 2 million individuals. Rwanda and Uganda are also home to the two largest primate species and both these countries can be easily combined with a wildlife safari.

Landscapes

There are a myriad of spectacular landscapes in East Africa - from the soaring mountains of Kilimanjaro and Kenya, the primate rich jungles in Rwanda and Uganda, the many rolling grassland savannahs and the long, wide beaches of the Indian Ocean coastline.

Activities & Culture

East Africa has numerous activities available from walking safaris to soaring over the plains in a hot air balloon. There are also a wide variety of cultures for guests to experience from the more famous Masai to the lesser known pygmy Batwa.

Food & Wine

Not a renowned destination for food but the properties offer delicious meals. There is also the option for guests to have a local cooking class in a village.

Beaches

Both Kenya and Tanzania have glorious beaches with the powder-white sand just a short flight away from the national parks and reserves.

Southern Africa

Wildlife

The wildlife in Southern Africa is less dense and trackers have to work a little harder to find them. However there are a larger number of close up wildlife interactions that make up for this. From walking with elephants in Botswana to meeting the Cape Penguins in Cape Town.

Landscapes

Southern Africa has a stunning variety of superbly contrasting landscapes. The deserts of Namibia with its rolling sand dunes onto the flat floodplains of the Okavango delta into the towering heights of the Drakensburg mountains.

Activities & Culture

Southern Africa not only offers safari activities but the wonderful cities of Cape Town and Johannesburg offer unusual art experiences, bike trips round the city and a myriad of cultural experiences from museums to walking tours with the locals.

Food & Wine

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day one: Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, meet the Akorn Guardian Angel and driver and overnight in Nairobi.

Day two: Drive to Amboseli National Park, South East of Nairobi close to the Northern Tanzania border. Arrive at the lodge in time for lunch and an afternoon game drive.

Day three: Head out on morning and afternoon game drives in Amboseli and capture the perfect Kilimanjaro shot; mornings are the best for this. In the afternoon visit the Oltiyani School supported by the Akorn Philanthropy Project: Safe Water For Schools.

Day four: Do a morning game drive out of the park to the Namanga Border. Here you will cross over into Tanzania and you will be met by the Tanzania guide and drive onto Karatu for the night.

Day five: Today game drive in the Ngorongoro Crater - known as the Garden of Eden. This is the best place to see black rhino in Tanzania.

Day six: Drive to the Serengeti National Park in the morning, enjoy the ever changing landscape below. Enjoy a picnic lunch on the way to maximise the time in the park.

Day seven: Enjoy further game drives in this amazing landscape. Keep a sharp lookout for the elusive predators like leopards and cheetahs.

Day eight: Fly across the border into the Masai Mara National Reserve. Immigration formalities are done at Tarime and Migori. Arrive at the lodge in time for lunch and an afternoon game drive.

Day nine: Head out on morning and afternoon game drives in the Masai Mara.

Day ten: Catch the flight back to Nairobi and the onwards international flight home.

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day one: Arrive at Kigali International Airport and overnight in Kigali.

Day two: After a morning tour of the city, including a visit to the very moving Genocide Memorial, drive to Volcanoes National Park.

Day three: After an early breakfast drive to the Gorilla Tracking HQ to meet the guides, porters and the other people tracking in the group. Tracking can take

anywhere from 45 minutes to five or more hours. Once trackers have reached the designated family they have one hour with them. Return to the lodge for lunch and optional afternoon activities.

Day four: Early this morning head out on a Golden Monkey Trek. This unusual species is endemic to the Virunga Volcanoes mountain chain. In the afternoon choose to explore the twin lakes on a walk followed by a canoe with a sundowner on board (additional cost).

Day five: Set out for Kigali early this morning to catch the midday flight to the Serengeti. Arrive in the afternoon and do a short game drive to the property.

Day six & seven: Spend the next two days exploring the Serengeti National Park on morning and afternoon game drives. There is the chance to do an early morning balloon safari (additional cost).

Day eight: Fly to the Lake Manyara Airstrip and transfer to the hotel for an afternoon at leisure.

Day nine: Set off for a full day game drive in the Ngorongoro Crater - the worlds largest unbroken caldera. Guests should keep an eye out for rhinos who call the crater their home.

Day ten: Drive to Arusha and relax in a day room before being transferred to Kilimanjaro International Airport for the flight home.
