ALILA VILLAS ULUWATU Bali, Indonesia

Perched on a limestone cliff overlooking the Indian Ocean, Alila Villas Uluwatu is an elegant retreat on Bali's southern peninsula. Designed to blend in with its surroundings, the property seamlessly integrates indoor and outdoor spaces with a collection of villas offering comfortable oceanside living and a selection of restaurants and a spa delivering added pampering and relaxation.

Why we love it: The spacious villas come with private pools and feature a breezy open-plan design combining elements of Balinese design, including wood, water, stone and rattan. RAFFLES GRAND HOTEL D'ANGKOR Siem Reap, Cambodia

Set to re-open in June 2022, Raffles Grand Hotel d'Angkor has become an icon of Siem Reap. Located opposite the royal residence, the property has hosted numerous international dignitaries and celebrities, from Jacqueline Kennedy, Michelle Obama and Charlie Chaplin, to name a few.

Why we love it: Following an extensive renovation in recent years, the hotel returns with upgraded interiors and a lighter, brighter feel, including warm, hardwood floors and quality amenities throughout, including oversized rain showers and clawfoot bathtubs. SALA AYUTTHAYA Ayutthaya, Thailand
