











ITINERARY

1 Arrive in Windhoek

Upon arrival at Windhoek International Airport, clearing customs and immigration, you will transfer to your hotel and overnight. The transfer duration is approximately 45 minutes. Windhoek, the capital of Namibia, is located at the geographic centre of the country surrounded by rolling mountains. It's not only the perfect place to start or finish your holiday, but well worth a visit in its own right. The influence of German colonization is still present in language, architecture and restaurants. During the day, the city centre has a European cafe culture feel, laid-back and eclectic, with a pedestrian precinct, bustling shops and market stalls.

2 Fly to Sossusvlei

Transfer to Windhoek International Airport for your private charter flight to Sossusvlei, transfer to the lodge and overnight. The flying time is one hour. Sossusvlei represents the classic view of the Namib Desert (known as the 'Sand Sea') with 'waves' that are made of bright red sand and dark shadows. Highlights in the area include the moon-like pans grandly flanked by some of the world's tallest dunes. Your day is at leisure to explore the activities offered by the camp.

3 Sossusvlei

Learn about the ecosystem on a Sossusvlei excursion, explore the dunes on foot or by quad bike with a specialist guide who will share the secrets of the dunes. Explore heritage sites and gain insight into the San people. Be mesmerised by the magnificence of the desert on morning or late afternoon desert drives that continue after nightfall. Traverse the stark beauty and vast expanse on an e-bike. Explore the lodge's surroundings on foot, take the time to sit in the stillness and be enchanted by the views.

4 Fly to Marienfluss Valley

Transfer to the airstrip for your private charter flight to the Marienfluss Valley, transfer to the camp and overnight. The flying time is approximately three hours and 20 minutes. Okahirongo River Camp is built on a sweeping ridge and showcases breath-taking views of the Kunene River and across into Angola. Flying in, you get an amazing perspective on the Marienfluss Valley. Lose yourself in all the lights and shades that the sun paints over the mountains, and let the Kunene River play its soothing flow as music for deep meditation.

Explore the mountain area and the riverine of the valley with your guide.

6 Fly to the Kaokoland Region

Depart by charter flight from Marienfluss Valley to the Kaokoland Region. The flying time is approximately one hour. On arrival, transfer to the lodge and overnight. Perched on a hill above the banks of the ephemeral Hoarusib River, the Okahirongo Elephant Lodge is an oasis of luxury nestled in the heart of the deserted Kaokoland, ensuring a rare tranquil experience.

7 & 8 Kaokoland Region

Spend your days exploring the Hoarusib River and activities offered by the lodge.

9 Drive to Damaraland

Enjoy a full day guided overland safari to the Damaraland and overnight. The rugged, rocky landscape is characterised by valleys and dry riverbeds that carve their way through deep gorges and ancient geological features. The area boasts the geologically fascinating Twyfelfontein World Heritage Site and the wildlife in the area is simply captivating and

includes the famous desert-adapted elephants and black rhino.

10 Damaraland

Explore the Damaraland with your guide, from nature drives and nature walks, desert adapted animal activities to rock art explorations, solar e-biking and trail treats. There is so much to discover in this unspoilt piece of Africa.


