



A Restful Retreat in Southern Laos

Where natural forests meet small villages, waterfalls and coffee plantations, this quiet corner of southern Laos offers an idyllic escape for outdoors adventurers. Wander the lush wilderness of the Bolaven Plateau or head further south to explore a landscape of four thousand islands in the middle of the Mekong River. We recommend staying on the riverside at Residence Bassac or at La Folie Lodge where you can go boating and biking by day and return for scenic sunsets by night - ideal for casual and relaxed countdown celebrations.

A Vietnamese Festive Favorite

Any great celebration comes with even greater food traditions. In Vietnam, the festive season is a cultural mixed bag, where Vietnamese spring rolls and noodles are served alongside roast turkey and pudding. As a former French colony, it is not surprising that the Vietnamese spread often features French delicacies such oysters and escargot, but nothing says "Celebration" in Vietnam more than a bûche de Noël, which you will find in many bakeries and restaurants this time of year – because who doesn't love a chocolate, cream-filled cake!



Welcome the New Year on a high and watch the first sunrise of 2023 from the peak of the Menoreh Hills, overlooking rice fields and farmland in Java, Indonesia. This magical moment is part of the week-long celebrations at Amanjiwo, an idyllic limestone sanctuary that lies just steps from the great Borobudur, the world's largest Buddhist temple complex. Take part in morning yoga sessions, learn traditional craft-making and cleanse your spirit with a Ruwatan purification ceremony followed by breakfast at the Progo River. On New Year's Eve, savor a seven-course Champagne dinner accompanied by colorful Javanese dance and musical performances leading up to the countdown at midnight.
