Riyadh

Riyadh is the modern capital of Saudi with an abundance of shops and restaurants, where you can see what everyday life is like for Saudis, but it is much more than that as you can also visit: - The National Museum, a national treasure and World Heritage Site, composed of eight galleries that tell the complete story of Arabian history - from the creation of the universe to the modern era. - UNESCO world Heritage site Diriyah, which is where the first Saudi State was established, and has a fabulous Arabian Horse museum.

- Old Town: Walk through ancient ruins including the once-splendid palace, houses and marketplace, including Masmak Fortress, in Riyadh's old quarter, built during the reign of Abdullah bin Rashid in 1895 A.D.

Jeddah

The Eastern port city of Jeddah has been attracting visitors from all corners of the Earth since ancient times. From explorers and traders to pilgrims, Jeddah has welcomed through its gates all cultures and it still is the case today. This all-year-round warm city is growing as a hub for music and arts, marine activities, and now international sports and entertainment events.

While its Corniche is the highlight of modern Jeddah, take a walk through this coastal city's UNESCO world heritage sites and let them whisper to you all the history its ruins have witnessed over the centuries. End your day by enjoying the burning colours of a sunset over the Red Sea.













Journey through the Saudi Desert

Follow ancient pilgrimmage routes to holy sites, venture through the Saudi desert, spend a night under its clear skies and be amazed by the unique landscape that surrounds you. From neverending sand dunes to towering red rock formations, Saudi Arabia is a destination that will leave you in awe of its natural beauty.

AlUla

Channel your inner childhood archaeologist and journey in the desert before reaching Saudi's hidden gem, AlUla. Few places in the world seem frozen in time, and this historical masterpiece certainly is one of them. The region holds 200,000 years of human history within it making it the perfect destination for history fanatics. Roam through the ancient city of Hegra, explore Dadan (once the most developed city of the Arabian Peninsula), and learn about the ancient beliefs, rituals, and practices in the 'open-air library' of Jabal Ikmah. Since the open-air museum's official reopening in 2020, the cultural Oasis of AlUla now shares its wonders once again with the outside world, as it did with pilgrims in the 1100s.

Ha'il

Located in the Northwestern part of Saudi Arabia, between Mount Shammar and Mount Salma, Ha'il is on one of the main pilgrimage routes from Iraq to Mecca and once rivaled Riyadh in size and importance. Once hailed as the capital of all desert Arabia and home to the Arabian poet, Hatim Al Tai, today, the city of Ha'il is famous for its international events. Home to the Desert Festival which celebrates areas of culture, and the International Rally where you can see rally cars, quad bikes, and motorcycles race through the Nafud desert. Ha'il is the perfect stop for those seeking history, and an action-packed adventure.

Jazan

Famous for its lush greenery and amazing scenery, Jazan is also known across the country for its flower men. The flowers they carry around their head is a tradition that dates back over 2,000 years. Assembled from herbs and flowers including marigolds, jasmine, and basil. It is believed that while some men carry them solely for aesthetic purposes, others adorn such garlands for medicinal reasons, warding off headaches and other illnesses. Stretched over 200 kilometres along the point of Saudi's Red Sea Coast, Jazan makes for a great holiday destination. In the winter months, enjoy the moderate temperature by learning about the province's history, wealth and culture.
