### **ITINERARY**

#### 1 Arrive in Johannesburg and fly to Greater Kruger National Park

Arrive at O.R. Tambo International Airport for your transfer to Federal Air Hangar. The transfer time is approximately 15 minutes. Depart by shared light aircraft flight to the airstrip where you will be met and transferred to your accommodation and overnight. The flying time is approximately one hour.

Known as Big Game Country, the world-renowned Park has several luxurious private reserves within and on its borders. Imagine breath-taking scenery, rich biodiversity and amazing wildlife encounters, open air dining or traditional cuisine under an African sky, superior personalised service, sensational game viewing and the adventure of a South African safari.

#### 4 Fly To Victoria Falls

After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip for your private light aircraft flight to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport. The flying time is approximately 30 minutes. Fly to Victoria Falls/Livingstone on a scheduled flight. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your accommodation and overnight. The transfer time is approximately 40 minutes.

Victoria Falls, a World Heritage Site, is the tourist capital of Zimbabwe. It lies on the southern bank of the Zambezi and has become a focal point for action-packed fun including enchanting sightseeing flights over the falls.

#### **5 Victoria Falls**

Spend your day exploring the town of Victoria Falls. A Zambezi River lunch or sunset cruise is one of the most popular activities in Victoria Falls. Typically lasting around two hours, the cruise explores sections of the upper Zambezi close to the Victoria Falls. A fun way of exploring the town is on the Bamba Tram - a return tram experience through Zambezi National Park, onto the historic Victoria Falls suspension bridge. You may disembark the tram and take in the impressive scenery of the Victoria Falls, the gorge and the Zambezi River down below.

#### 6 Fly to the Okavango Delta

Meet your guide in the reception area of your accommodation and transfer to Kasane International Airport (clearing customs and immigrations enroute). The transfer time is approximately one hour and 30 minutes. Upon arrival at Kasane International Airport you will be met and depart by shared light aircraft flight to the Okavango Delta, transfer to your accommodation and overnight. The flying time is approximately one hour and 20 minutes.

#### 7 & 8 Okavango Delta

Spend your days enjoying the activities on offer.

The Okavango Delta is the largest inland delta in the world, and instead of flowing into the sea, the annual flood of fresh water flows inland, spreading over 15,000 kilometres of the Kalahari sand in a maze of lagoons and channels. The game viewing opportunities in these areas are awe-inspiring. On the plains one may find the roaming lions that prey on the thousands of antelope, zebra and buffalo who live here all year round. There are also healthy populations of wild dog. Mokoros, local dugout canoes, offer a different perspective of the bush in the company of a highly trained local guide. For the more adventurous, take a guided bush walk to gain a detailed understanding of this diverse environment, which features gems such as red lechwe bounding through marshy areas, a kaleidoscope of birdlife, plus predators and big game.

#### 9 Fly to Cape Town

After breakfast, transfer to the airstrip for your shared light aircraft flight to Maun International Airport. The flying time is approximately 30 minutes. Depart Maun on a scheduled flight to Cape Town. The flying time is approximately two hours and 40 minutes. Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport, after immigration and clearing customs, you will be met and transferred to your accommodation and overnight.

It has, in recent years, been named the best place in the world to visit by leading international media – and the reasons for this are unmistakable.
