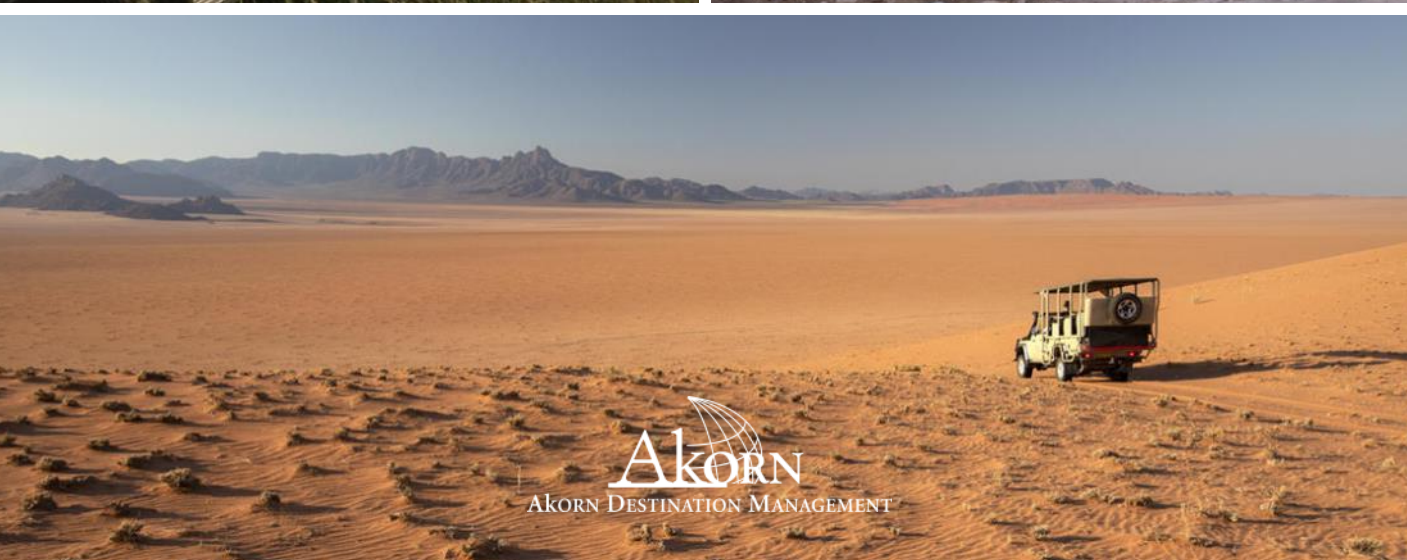


# Classic Namibia

## ITINERARY

### 1 Arrive in Windhoek

Upon arrival at Hosea Kutako International Airport, after clearing customs and immigration, you will be assisted with collection of your rental vehicle, drive to your accommodation and overnight. The driving time is approximately 45 minutes.

Windhoek, the capital of Namibia, is located at the geographic centre of the country surrounded by rolling mountains. It's not only the perfect place to start or finish your holiday, but well worth a visit in its own right. The influence of German colonization is still present in language, architecture and restaurants. During the day, the city centre has a European cafe culture feel, laid-back and eclectic, with a pedestrian precinct, bustling shops and market stalls.

### 2 Self-drive to NamibRand Nature Reserve (Sossusvlei)

Depart Windhoek on a self-drive basis to NamibRand Nature Reserve, located in the southern region of the country. The NamibRand Nature Reserve was established to help protect and conserve the unique ecology and wildlife of the Namib Desert. It is arguably the largest private nature reserve in Southern Africa. All facets of the Namib Desert are represented – sand and gravel plains, stretches of savannah, mountain ranges and vegetated dune belts. Spend your afternoon enjoying the activities on offer. The driving time is approximately five hours.

### 4 Self-drive to Swakopmund

Depart NamibRand Nature Reserve on a self-drive basis to Swakopmund. The driving time is approximately five hours. Swakopmund is a coastal town situated at the edge of the Namib Desert, west of the capital city Windhoek. Suggested activities include scenic helicopter flights, historical town tours, sandboarding, quad biking, living dune experiences, kayaking, welwitschia tours, hot-air ballooning, boat cruises dolphin and seal cruises, fat bike tours, fishing and 4x4 drives in the dunes.

### 6 Self-drive to Damaraland

Depart Swakopmund on a self-drive basis to Damaraland. Damaraland is a massive, untamed and rugged area which is part of the Kunene Region in the north-west of Namibia. Highlights of Damaraland include the Brandberg Mountains - home to the endangered desert-adapted elephant which can be seen roaming around dry riverbeds, and Twyfelfontein, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with hundreds of unique rock engravings. The driving time is approximately four hours and 30 minutes.

### 9 Self-drive to Etosha National Park

Depart Damaraland on a self-drive basis to the Etosha. This is one of Namibia's premier wildlife sanctuaries and home to a variety of wildlife including the endangered cheetah and black rhino. Etosha means the "great white area" and refers to the huge salt pan. This is an impressive sight, one of the largest salt pans in Southern Africa. The driving time is approximately four hours.

Depart Etosha on a self-drive basis to Windhoek. The driving time is approximately five hours. Spend your day at leisure exploring the city.

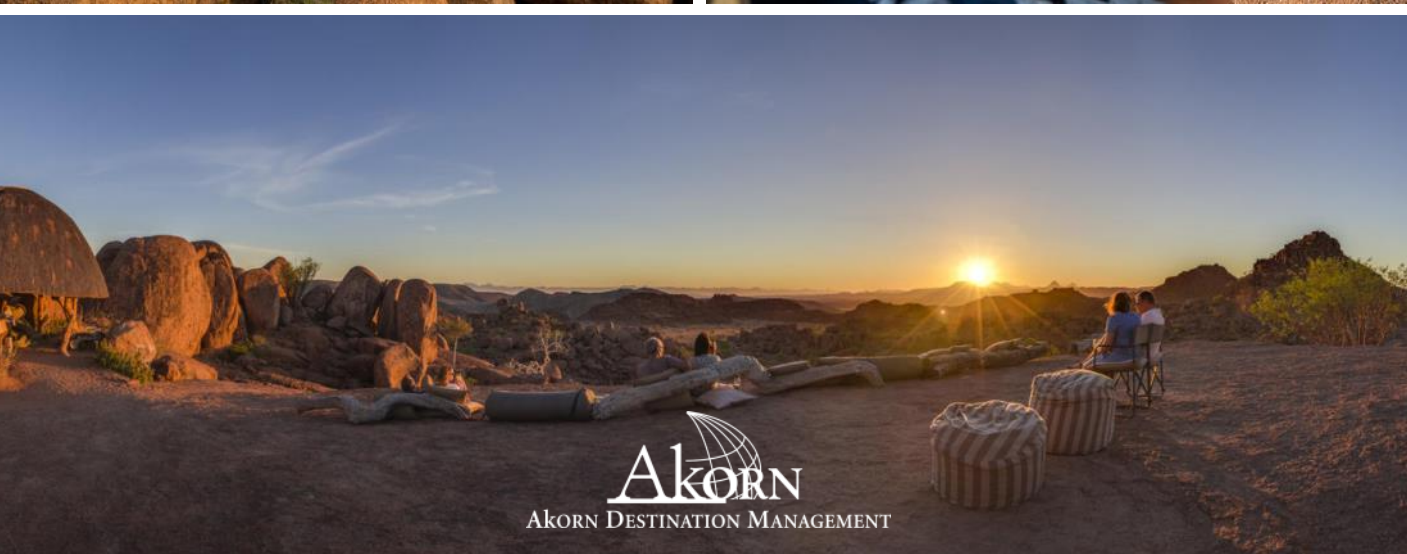
