WHY NAMIBIA?

Namibia is a country in Southern Africa whose western border is the Atlantic Ocean. It shares land borders with Angola and Zambia to the north, Botswana to the east and South Africa to the south and east.

For many travelers Namibia does not rank highly on the bucket list. This is both brilliant and a travesty at the same time; brilliant because it still feels so remote, untouched and vast – you'll often be the only souls watching over a herd of desert-adapted elephants and yet a travesty because Namibia is so extraordinary as to leave visitors dumbfounded.

Don't go to Namibia expecting endless herds or animals at every corner. Namibia is all about the desert landscape – ever changing, and evermore otherworldly. It is home to wildlife that have adapted to living in the harsh conditions of their desert environment like the oryx, the largest number of free-roaming desert-adapted black rhino, and bat-eared foxes.

Perhaps the most adapted of all, is its people: the ochre-red hair of the Himba, the clicking speech of the Damara, the fascinating San Bushmen of the Kalahari, and the German descendants of Swakopmund.

BEST TIME TO TRAVEL

The sand dunes of Sossusvlei can be visited at any time of the year however the dry winter climate from March to October is the best time to visit. September and October can get very hot. October to April is summer and the best time for bird watching. May to August is winter and the best time for game viewing in Etosha National Park. June and July can have very cold nights. November and April is the summer rainy season turning the area green and bringing the occasional floods to the desert.








KAOKOLAND

Kaokoveld is a mountainous landscape of rugged beauty, considered one of the last remaining wilderness areas in Southern Africa. It is part of the Kunene Region in the far north-west of Namibia, bordered by the Kunene River in the north, the Atlantic Ocean in the west and the Central North Region in the east and the Damaraland. The area is also home to the Himba: a semi-nomadic people indigenous to this arid environment. Best time to travel: The best time to visit Kaokoland is in the dry season which is from May to October as the weather remains pleasant and warm.



NAMIBRAND NATURE RESERVE

Located in the south of the country, the NamibRand Nature Reserve was established in 1984 to help protect and conserve the unique ecology and wildlife of the southwest Namib Desert. It is probably the largest private nature reserve in Southern Africa. The reserve shares a border with the Namib-Naukluft National Park in the west and is bordered in the east by the imposing Nubib Mountains. Virtually all facets of the Namib Desert are represented – sand and gravel plains, stretches of savannah, mountain ranges and vegetated dune belts. Best time to travel: Between January to April and also November to December when temperatures are warmer.



Etosha National Park, said to have 114 species of mammal and 340 species of bird, is one of the great wildlife viewing areas in the country. Perennial springs attract giraffe, elephant, birds and big cats. Etosha means the "great white area" and refers to the huge salt pan. This is an impressive sight, the biggest salt pan in Africa. Best time to travel: Dry season in the winter months of July to October. This is when many of the animals are concentrated at waterholes and the grass is low, allowing for a better viewing experience.







DAMARALAND

Damaraland is a massive, untamed and rugged area which is also part of the Kunene Region in the north-west of Namibia. It is located between the Brandberg and the little village of Sesfontein. The flora and fauna of the region have adapted perfectly to the harsh weather conditions of high heat and persisting droughts. Here you find the desert-dwelling elephants and the critically endangered desert lions which have managed to adapt to the arid climate. Highlights of Damaraland include the Brandberg Mountains - home to the endangered desert elephant which can be seen roaming around areas of dry riverbed, and Twyfelfontein, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with its unique rock engravings. Best time to travel: The dry season from May to October is considered as the best time to visit as animals gather near the waterholes, making the game viewing easier.




SKELETON COAST

The hauntingly beautiful and windswept Skeleton Coast which covers an area of two million hectares, is an eerie yet fascinating landscape and one of the most unusual coastlines in the world. It is named after the numerous remains of shipwrecks and giant whale skeletons that have littered the desolate landscape. There is rich bird and sea life all over the area, including Cape Fur seal colonies and inland desert elephants, oryx, giraffe, Brown hyena and lion. Walvis Bay Lagoon is regarded as the most important wetland for coastal birds in Southern Africa, with about 200,000 birds stopping here on their migration to and from the Arctic. Best time to travel: Spring and summer months from October to March. These months see a little bit of rain, with clear skies clear, less foggy mornings and warmer nights.



SOSSUSVLEI (NAMIBRAND RESERVE)

A photographer's paradise, Sossusvlei is a clay pan in the central Namib Desert. Fed by the Tsauchab River, it is known for the towering red sand dunes which surround it and which, at 300 metres (984 feet) high, are the highest in the world. Vegetation, such as the Camelthorn tree, is watered by infrequent floods of the Tsauchab River, which slowly soak into the underlying clay. The best views of the dunes are at sunrise, when the rich colours make for fabulous photo opportunities. Best time to travel: Sossusvlei is an all-year-round destination, however from late June to October there is no rain with perfect blue skies.


