Location: Tracking takes place at the Volcanoes National Park in the North West of the country

Altitude: Between 2,500m (8,200ft) and 4,000m **Altitude**: Between 1,160m (3,805ft) and 2,600m

Gorilla families: 12 habituated gorilla families

Gorilla Permits: There are 8 gorilla permits issued per gorilla family per day, a maximum of 96 permits

Cost: \$1,500 per person per track

Age: Minimum age for tracking is 15 years

Tracking time: Tracking takes place once a day

in the morning

Terrain: High altitude, moderately steep

Access: 4 hour drive to Musanze

Location: Tracking takes place in Bwindi Impenetrable Forest and Mgahinga National Park

Gorilla families: 17 in Bwindi and 1 in Mgahinga

Gorilla Permits: There are 8 gorilla permits issued per gorilla family per day, a maximum of 136 permits in Bwindi and 8 in Mgahinga

Cost: \$700 per person per track

Age: Minimum age for tracking is 15 years

Duration: Viewing time is limited to 1 hour

Tracking time: Tracking takes place once a day

in the morning

Permits sold by: Uganda Wildlife Authority

Terrain: Low altitude, quite steep

Access: Kihihi or Kisoro Airstrips
