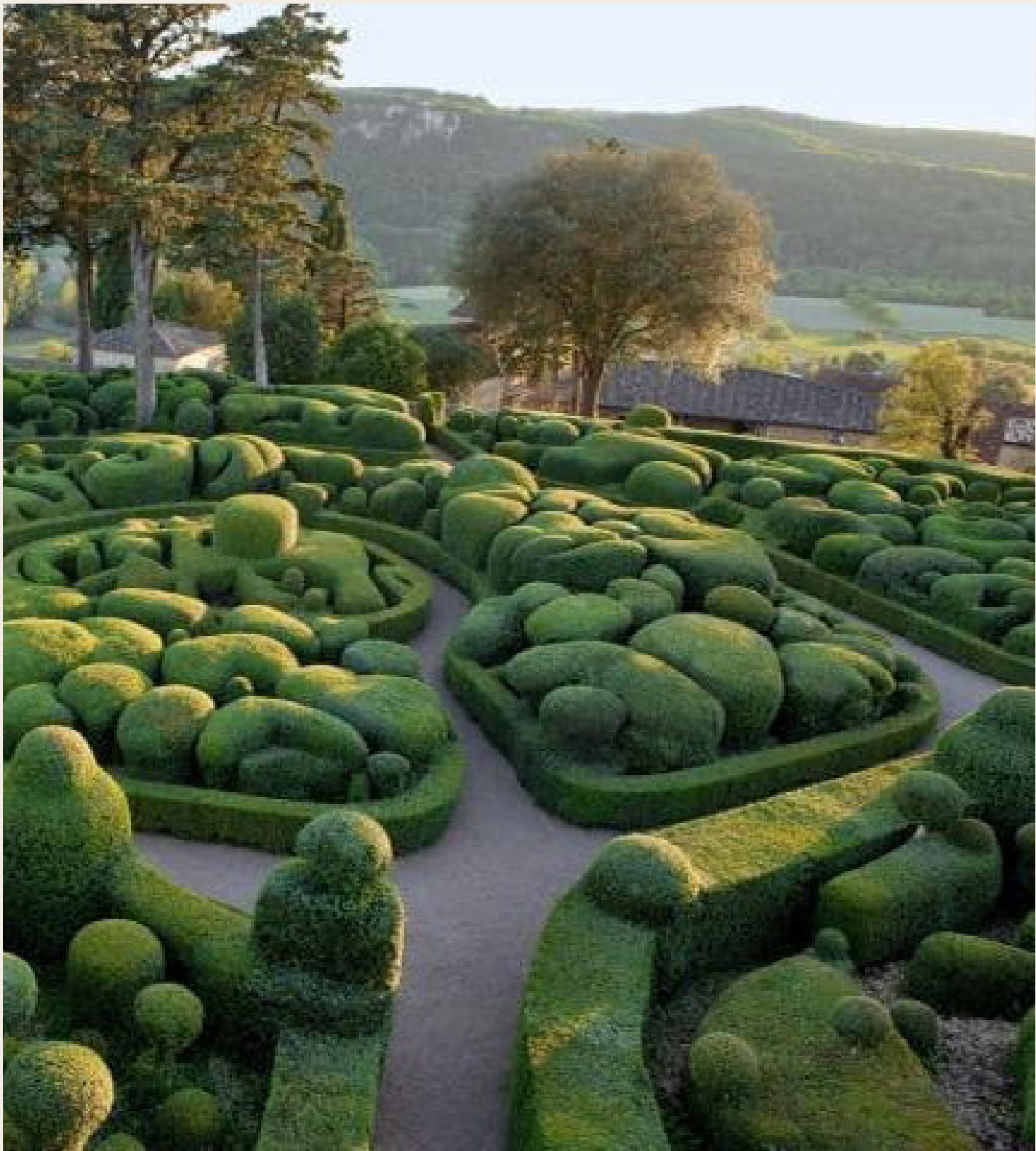
TIMELESS PARISIAN CHOCOLATIER
