




FUTEVÔLEI ON THE BEACH WITH LOCALS






VOICES OF VIDIGAL


BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE BIRD PARK

Embark on a behind-thescenes adventure at Parque Das Aves, next to Iguaçu National Park. Access restricted areas, encounter remarkable bird species up close and discover conservation efforts to protect the feathered locals.

MACUCO SAFARI

A fun and refreshing boat adventure through the Iguassu river. Get ready to feel the power of the falls up close and get soaking wet as the boat approaches the base of the waterfalls.



POÇO PRETO BIKE TRAIL

Cycle through the heart of the Iguaçu National Park, deep into the Atlantic Rainforest. This round-trip journey of approximately 18km (11.18 miles) is the perfect spot for birdwatching and a unique opportunity to connect with one of the world's most biodiverse ecosystem.



Enjoy a scenic 1.5 km (0.93 miles) walk through lush surroundings to the banks of the majestic Iguassu River. Along the way, enjoy a picturesque lookout with a deck offering unparalleled views of the river feeding the iconic Iguassu Falls. This serene trail offers a breathtaking perspective of the powerful waters just before they form the falls.

CAPOEIRA SCHOOL

Capoeira Angolana is the slower and more intricate of the two main Capoeira styles. Known for its deep philosophy, it emphasizes respect and cultural identity. On this tour, visit a traditional Capoeira school, meet group leaders, learn about its history and philosophy, try the instruments and practice basic movements.



Bahia is the rhythmic heart of Brazil, with a rich African-influenced percussion culture that has attracted global artists like Paul Simon and Michael Jackson. In this interactive workshop, a local professional percussionist will guide you through Bahia's rhythms, offering an fun experience for all.



COOKING CLASS AT CHEF'S HOUSE Visit Salvador's lively



WATERFALLS & CANYONS

Walk through pristine forest to natural pools and hidden gems like Boca da Onça—the tallest waterfall in the state—and Buraco do Macaco, where a swim beneath a giant rock reveals a secret cascade. Enjoy views of the Salobra River canyon and the Serra da Bodoquena from the Mirante do Rapel.

FLOATING OVER RIO DA PRATA


In Bonito you experience the rivers by floating gently with the current—no swimming required. Start your adventure on forest trails leading to the crystal-clear Olho d'Água River. As you float along, fish and swaying aquatic plants surround you in a magical setting. Near its meeting with the Rio da Prata, continue floating or navigate on an electric boat.



MACAWS IN ARARAS CAVE

Witness the spectacle of nearly 100 red macaws in this natural sanctuary. Follow a scenic trail to two lookout points with sweeping views. From May to December, the breeding season adds even more life to this vibrant haven.






RAFTING THE FORMOSO RIVER

Join a rafting trip down the Formoso River in a inflatable boat. Enjoy lush forest views, spot wildlife and navigate three waterfalls and two rapids along a 5 km (3.10 miles) route. A refreshing swim stop completes this experience.

FORMOSO EXPERIENCE

Start with a forest walk to a scenic lookout, then soar through the treetops on a zipline. Challenge yourself with a suspended obstacle trail and cool off with a swim down the Formoso River, where rapids are included. Finish with a short hike and enjoy Lagoa's leisure area, with kayaks, paddleboards, zipline, trampoline and more for a full day of outdoor fun.

NATURAL POOLS


Navigate through the vibrant forest on a solar-powered boat, then follow a scenic trail to waterfalls and natural pools perfect for a refreshing swim. Suspended walkways and lookout points reveal stunning views of the Serra da Bodoquena.




BLUE LAGOON CAVE

Follow a trail to a cave entrance, then descend into a world of magical stalactites, stalagmites and ancient secrets. Discover a mysterious underground lake inhabited by albino shrimp and fossils of ancient times.

A JOURNEY THROUGH THE CACAO COAST

Explore the history and flavors of the Cacao Coast on a cultural tour of Taboquinhas, once the region's cacao hub. 


CAMAMU BAY

Discover the fascinating nocturnal habits of ocelots, anteaters, jaguars, caimans and more animals on a thrilling nighttime adventure.


forest and discover the richness of the Pantanal's flora. As you walk along the trails, gain fascinating insights into the diverse plant life and the stories it holds.





BICYCLE RIDE OR NATURE WALK

Explore breathtaking trails by bike or on foot with a naturalist guide. Along the way, learn about local wildlife and village life, with refreshing stops at waterfalls and scenic viewpoints, a magical blend of nature, culture and adventure.




Follow a scenic trail to the iconic Big Family sculptures atop Pedra do Tatu. Created by American artist Karen Cusolito using reclaimed materials, these towering figures—some reaching up to 9 meters (29.52 feet)—symbolize regeneration and harmony between people and nature.





STAND-UP PADDLE ON LAGO NEGRO

Glide across the calm waters of Lago Negro, a peaceful lake surrounded by lush greenery. Whether on a paddleboard or in a canoe, it's the perfect place to cool off, relax and enjoy family time in the heart of nature.



PIJAMA PARTY IN A TRADITIONAL OCA


Spend a night in a traditional oca, the ancestral home of native Brazilians. Built by local artisans, this place offers a pijama party filled with stories and connection to nature. Perfect for families with children.

Arrive at the lagoon by bike and begin your experience with a refreshing swim in its crystal-clear waters. This is the birthplace of the Formoso River.


Glide across the lagoon and observe aquatic birds.
