

PRIVATE MACUCO SAFARI

There are so many ways to see the Iguassu Falls: walk behind them, fly over them, sail up to them, or, for guests looking for something more thrilling, take a Macuco Safari. On a two-hour private tour, they sail up the Iguassu River on board a Macuco motorized boat. The smaller, private boats are able to go right up to the roaring falls, guaranteeing that each and every guest on board will be soaked, but surrounded by nature, before the tour is over.

VISITING BOTH SIDES OF THE FALLS **i**

Iguassu boasts a variety of views and an array of activities and excursions from different sides of the falls. At Akorn we always encourage guests to visit both the Brazilian and the Argentinian sides, for a full experience of this wonder. On the Brazilian side, enjoy breathtaking panoramic views and feel the power of nature from a catwalk that sits on the Devil's Throat. Embrace your experience further and discover the ecosystem from a helicopter ride, a backstage visit to the renowned bird park or on a rafting trip above the falls. On the other hand, the Argentine side offers a closer view. Thanks to their longer catwalks, pristine forests and the chance of setting foot on the Devil's Throat fall or the San Martin Island, you can enjoy a completely different experience of Iguassu.

AMAZONIA

Hosting more than 60% of the Amazon rainforest -including the largest protected areas-, it is no wonder Brazil is the first country that comes to mind when one thinks of the Amazon. The vast expansiveness of the world's largest forest and biggest river can truly be felt here. A unique feature of the Brazilian Amazon is seeing the meeting of the waters just outside of Manaus, where the Rio Negro and the Salomões Rivers converge, bringing to life the mythic Amazon River. The Amazon forest in Brazil is also teeming with wildlife with sloths and the emblematic pink river dolphins. The region can be appreciated comfortably without many mosquitoes, thanks to the PH balance of the Rio Negro.

MANAUS

Not just the capital of the vast state of Amazonas but also an Amazonian icon, Manaus is the gateway to the Brazilian Amazon Rain Forest. Guests visiting this beautiful city will be able to enjoy the benefits of its versatility since here, they can enjoy thrilling adventures to the vast Amazonia, relax on beautiful jungle river beaches, go on an exciting journey in search of waterfalls or marvel at the luxurious Amazonian Theatre, legacy of the 19th century Rubber Boom.

ORCHESTRA PERFORMANCE IN THE AMAZON

ANAVILHANAS JUNGLE LODGE

Anavilhanas Jungle Lodge is an exclusive property situated in the heart of the Brazilian Amazon just up the river from Manaus. Resting in front of Anavilhanas archipelago, the lodge is touched by the black waters of the Rio Negro and is blessed with the sounds, smells and mysteries of the Amazon Jungle. Nearly free of mosquitoes and nestled within a vast stretch of untouched rain forest, the hotel offers a wonderful balance between nature and comfort, adventure and peace. The hotel is accessible by land or by float-plane.

PANTANAL

The world's largest tropical wetland. It is so large that it knows no borders and extends 195,000 kilometers squared through Brazil, Bolivia and Paraguay; a true wonder of Mother Nature! Besides the unique colorful fauna that is found in Pantanal, some of the species that call this place home are: capybaras, tapirs, howler monkeys and the majestic jaguar! In fact, Pantanal is considered to be the wildlife sanctuary of South America and the best place in the world to see wild Jaguars.

NORTH PANTANAL



North Pantanal begins 120km south of Cuiabá, the capital city of Mato Grosso state. The region is traversed by the Transpantaneira road - a raised dirt track with over 100 wooden bridges. Those willing to make the effort to travel to the end of the road will not only get more chances to see wildlife along the ride, but to be rewarded with a sighting of the elusive jaguar. This is one of the few places in the world where -during the months of June to October- there are very good chances of seeing wild jaguars in their natural habitat.

SOUTH PANTANAL



Southern Pantanal offers a more intense natural experience, thanks to the wide array of wildlife that can be seen here. Some of the species that call this place home are: parrots, toucans, macaws, caimans, howler monkeys or giant otters, just to mention a few. Southern Pantanal floods much more than the north, which causes an increase of aquatic vegetation, which consequently means more animals to see!



JAGUAR SUITES

Right in the heart of "Jaguarland" along the Piquiri River, the Jaguar Suites is a floating barge with high-quality hospitality experience. The eight spacious suites with full-length windows and verandas is one of the only places where you might see a jaguar from your room. Daily excursions on comfortable skiffs provide great chances to see jaguars, giant river otters, large caiman and capybaras among other regional wildlife.



CAIMÁN ECOLOGE

The best combination of wildlife and hospitality in Brazil's Southern Pantanal. Composed of three independent complexes, Caiman has one of the largest protected private reserves. The lodge offers a variety of experiences designed to appreciate the unique wildlife of the region. Don't miss the opportunity to accompany a biologist from the Onçafari program monitoring the various jaguars on the property.



Jaguars can be spotted from June through October. This thanks to the dry season, which makes roads more accessible.



There are close to 10 million caimans in Pantanal, and it is easier to spot them during the dry season, due to dwindling lagoons.



The driest season in Campo Grande is from June through August. On the other hand, in Cuiabá, it's from mid-May through mid-September.



Monsoon season in Campo Grande is from mid-September to mid-May. As per Cuiabá, it is from October to April

SALVADOR DA BAHIA

Founded in 1549, it was Brazil's first capital, and currently one of our most important cities, which truly represents the soul of Brazil. The unique cuisine, music and architecture found in Salvador tell the story of Brazil, with intriguing combinations of European, African and native South American influences. It's no wonder the historic center of the city, known as Pelourinho has been recognized as an UNESCO cultural heritage site. The unique colors, rhythms and flavors of Salvador Bahia, allow travelers to feel Brazil's soul full of life.

MARKET AND COOKING EXPERIENCE

FASANO SALVADOR

The Fasano Hotel Salvador benefits from a privileged location in the city where history, the iconic Castro Alves Square and a wonderful view of All-Saints Bay contribute to the ambiance. 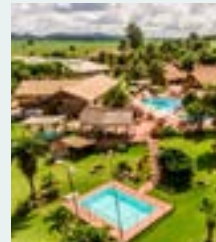

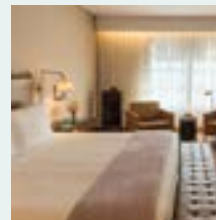

ULTIMATE COFFEE EXPERIENCE

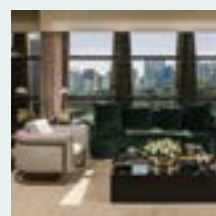

Only one island is inhabitable and accessed with daily commercial flights from Recife and Natal.



POUSADA MARAVILHA HOTEL

Everything at Pousada Maravilha frames the view: the infinity pool, the wide balconies in each of the eight accommodations with hot tubs and hammocks, and the spectacular dining area, which houses one of Noronha's best restaurants. No matter where you stand, the Sueste beach is always in view. With one of the highest staff to guest ratio on the island, the property prides itself on offering impeccable service.



ITACARÉ

Between Salvador and Ilheus is Itacaré, a beach town that, back in the day, served as one of the first Portuguese colonial settlements. At first, Itacaré may seem like a normal coastal town, but the deeper you walk into its history, the more you will fall in love with this place; home to unspoiled nature, delectable food, tranquility and 33km (20 mi) of white-sand beach. It is all these elements combined that make this destination such a perfect place for those in search of a break.



TXAI ITACARÉ RESORT

A fantastic getaway in the Atlantic Rainforest along the coast of southern Bahia. The unique property is among Brazil's best beach resorts delivering on all aspects, from the spacious bungalows, the nearly private beaches, a gourmet restaurant and the incredible hill-top spa featuring panoramic views of the cacao coast. From here guests can visit a local cacao farm to learn where chocolate comes from or learn about Txai's sea turtle protection program.



TRANCOSO

Just 30 km (18.5 mi) from Puerto Seguro Airport, framed by cotton-like white sand, hills, cliffs and coconut palms, sits Trancoso. 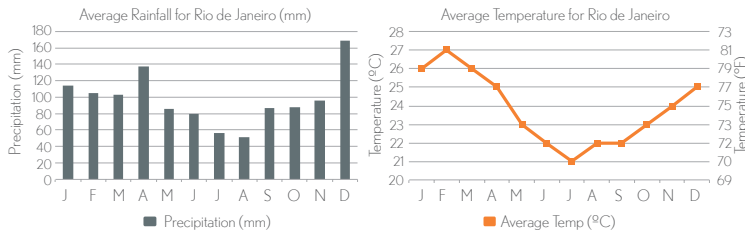

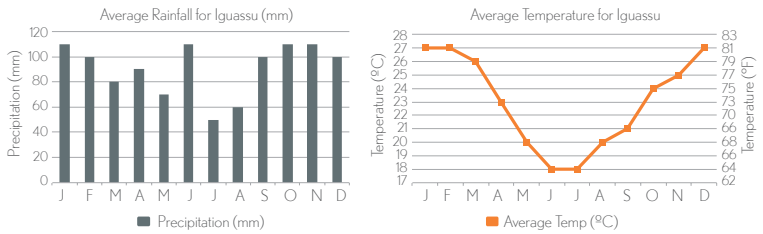

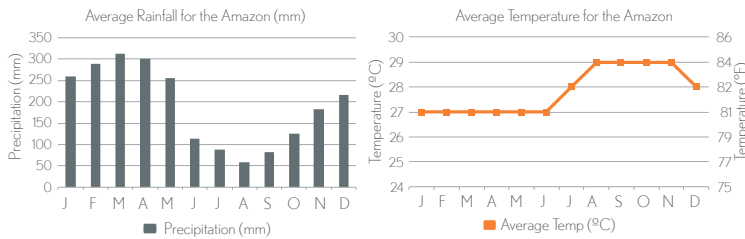
TEMPERATURE CHART FOR RIO DE JANEIRO



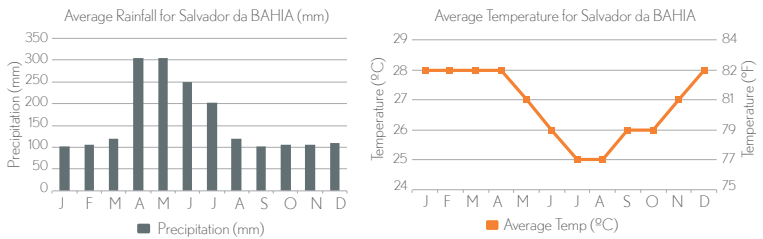
TEMPERATURE CHART FOR IGUASSU



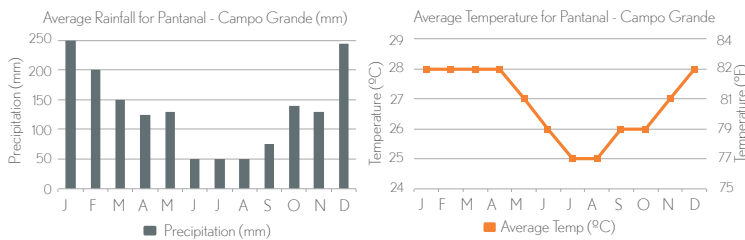
TEMPERATURE CHART FOR THE AMAZON



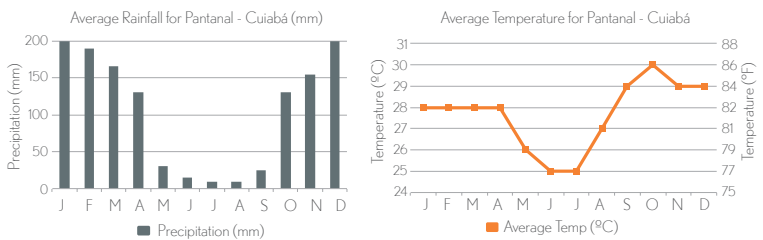
TEMPERATURE CHART FOR SALVADOR DA BAHIA
